



BAINBRIDGE ARTS & CRAFTS 2017 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Bainbridge Arts & Crafts offers three scholarships to graduating seniors: The Pauli Family Scholarship (\$2,000), the Rosalyn Gale Powell Scholarship (\$1,000), and The Pauli & George Dennis Scholarship (\$1,000).

Any graduating senior who resides on Bainbridge Island or attends Bainbridge High School or Eagle Harbor High School, and who plans to continue the study of art in college, may apply.

- The **Pauli Family Scholarship** is awarded to a student who demonstrates excellence in one or more mediums.
- The **Rosalyn Gale Powell Scholarship** is awarded to a student who demonstrates excellence in one medium.
- The **Pauli & George Dennis Scholarship** is awarded to a student of the jury's choice who demonstrates excellence in one or more mediums.

Scholarship judges are professional artists who are represented by Bainbridge Arts & Crafts, and who volunteer their time. Their decisions are made on the basis of mastery of medium, creativity, presentation, and artist statement.

HOW TO APPLY

Step One: Submit a written application that includes the following:

- Personal information: Name, address, phone number, and name of current high school.
- Artist statement (maximum of 300 words): Discuss how your artwork has developed, what mediums interest you and why, what your plans for future study of art are, and a brief statement about your other interests.
- Education goals: State your plans for enrollment in an accredited college or art school.

Email your written application to Bainbridge Arts & Crafts Programming and Outreach Director Georgia Browne at georgia@bacart.org. You will receive an email confirmation as proof of your submission.

DEADLINE: Applications are due by end of day Monday, April 17.

Step Two: Present a display of your work

On Wednesday, April 26, arrange a display of your work in the space provided in BHS Room 112. If your display includes work from three or more mediums, you will be eligible for consideration for all three scholarships. If your work includes only one medium, you will be eligible for consideration for the Rosalyn Gale Powell Scholarship or the Pauli & George Dennis Scholarship. If you have questions about display space, please speak with Ms. Rowland at BHS.

Important jury notes:

- You will set up your work between 3:00 and 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 26.
- No students will be admitted to the room during the jurying.
- All artwork must be picked up on Thursday morning, April 27, before 8:30a.m.

SCHOLARSHIP NOTIFICATIONS

Scholarship winners will be contacted by Bainbridge Arts & Crafts within three days of judging.

Winners will officially be announced at the reception for the High School Spring Arts Festival exhibition in the Bainbridge High School Commons on Thursday, May 11.

Scholarships will be officially presented at the Senior Awards Ceremony in the Bainbridge High School Commons on Thursday, June 8, at 7:00p.m.

DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS

Checks will be written directly to the recipient's college or university and mailed to the Registrar. It is the student's responsibility to tell Bainbridge Arts & Crafts where to direct payment. At least two weeks prior to registration, please provide the following information to BAC Business Manager John Donbeck, john@bacart.org:

- Proof of enrollment
- Student ID number
- Address where BAC can direct payment.

Before checks are sent to your new school, scholarship winners must also write a letter of acknowledgement and thanks:

- Direct acknowledgment of The Pauli Family Scholarship to *The Pauli Family*, in care of Bainbridge Arts & Crafts.
- Direct acknowledgment of the Rosalyn Gale Powell Scholarship to the *Board of Trustees of Bainbridge Arts & Crafts*, in care of Bainbridge Arts & Crafts.
- Direct acknowledgment of the Pauli & George Dennis Scholarship to *The Dennis Family*, in care of Bainbridge Arts & Crafts.

You will also be expected to send a note sometime during the school year briefly reporting on art classes and experiences that have made a particular impression.
